RE: Borough of Closter Sign Ordinance – Election Signs

Dear Property Owner,

The Borough of Closter is providing the Borough's Code, to inform and clarify any questions or concerns regarding the Borough's Sign Ordinance. In particular, section 173-83 (5) refers to Election signs posted within the Borough of Closter.

Your cooperation is very much appreciated.

“§ 173-83. Sign requirements.

(5)

Election signs. Temporary election signs shall not be erected prior to 30 days before any election and shall be removed not more than four days after the election. Cost of removal after that time shall be charged to the responsible entity which must be included on each sign. Such signs shall not be larger than 16 by 26 inches (or four square feet) or be higher than three feet from the ground. Election signs only may be placed closer than six feet from the curblin. It shall be unlawful for any person to post a political campaign and/or promotional sign on any street, sidewalk, or curb, and no political campaign and/or promotional sign shall be affixed to any tree, shrub, utility pole, light pole, telephone pole or other structure lying in or over a public easement. All political campaign and/or promotional signs shall be set back at least three feet from all street lines. Not more than 3/10 of the square footage of any window or window display area shall be covered by political and/or promotional signs. All political and/or promotional signs shall clearly identify the person responsible for posting same. Political campaign and/or promotional signs in violation of this section are hereby declared to be a public nuisance and may be abated as such by the Borough's Code Enforcement Officer.”
