REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

2. Approval of the SEPTEMBER 15, 2022 Meeting Minutes

Mr. Neusch motioned to approve the MAY 19th Meeting Minutes with one correction and Dr. Baron seconded. The motion carried unanimously.

4. Reports

a. <u>Health Officer</u>

b. Registered Environmental Health Specialist.

 - b. Rabies Clinic in January 7, 2023 was discussed including usage of Senior Center as a venue for this Rabies Clinic. The Board agreed on the date and the place.
 - c. Review/Adopting of Meeting Dates for Year 2023. The Board agreed on its 2023 year Calendar as follows; January 5, 2023- Reorganization, March 15, May 18, July 20, September 21 and November 16.  - d. Propose Mid-Bergen Regional Health Commission Contract was discussed by the Board and tabled the matter until re-organization meeting of the Mayor and Council in January 2023 to vote on the contract Budget 2023. The board voted on the contract with 3.5% increase the motion was made by Ms. Oliver, seconded by Ms. Pierro. Motion cared unanimously.
 - e. For year 2023 budget for the Board of Health was reviewed with all operating line items and adjustments from last year. The HARP contract has not yet received and not yet acted upon by the Mayor and Council for budget approval. Motioned was made by Mr. Neusch, seconded by Dr. Baron. Motion cared unanimously.

Julie Brueck, resident of 26 John Street was present during the meeting, she discussed animal licensing.
