Tree fines. The Mayor suggested that residents should be allowed to appeal to the municipal court rather than the Mayor and Council. The Mayor said fines could be left as it, wiped away, or reduced. Councilman Devlin suggested changing the ordinance to fine the contractors. The attorney pointed out that municipal courts are often limited in the amount of fines they can levy and they often can only impose fines. The attorney will look at the ordinance.

Councilman Devlin moved to change the fine to the contractors. Councilman Yammarino stated that people should be allowed to improve their properties. The attorney stated that the contract with the contractor could state that the homeowner has to indemnify the contractor. The Police Chief stated that what the building on Harrington did made it beautiful. He also talked about the great improvement made at 472 High Street. He suggested having people add trees not pay fines. Councilwoman Latner said that people really didn't know what to do and were trying to make improvements. The Mayor related that he sensed a consensus to put these fines in abeyance. The appeals in the future should go to the courts and the fines should go to the contractor. The Mayor told the homeowners that they are off the hook and the fines will be reissued to the contractors. The attorney restated that there may then be issues between homeowner and contractor. Councilwoman Amitai reminded all that the Construction Department will be telling tree companies about the ordinances.
