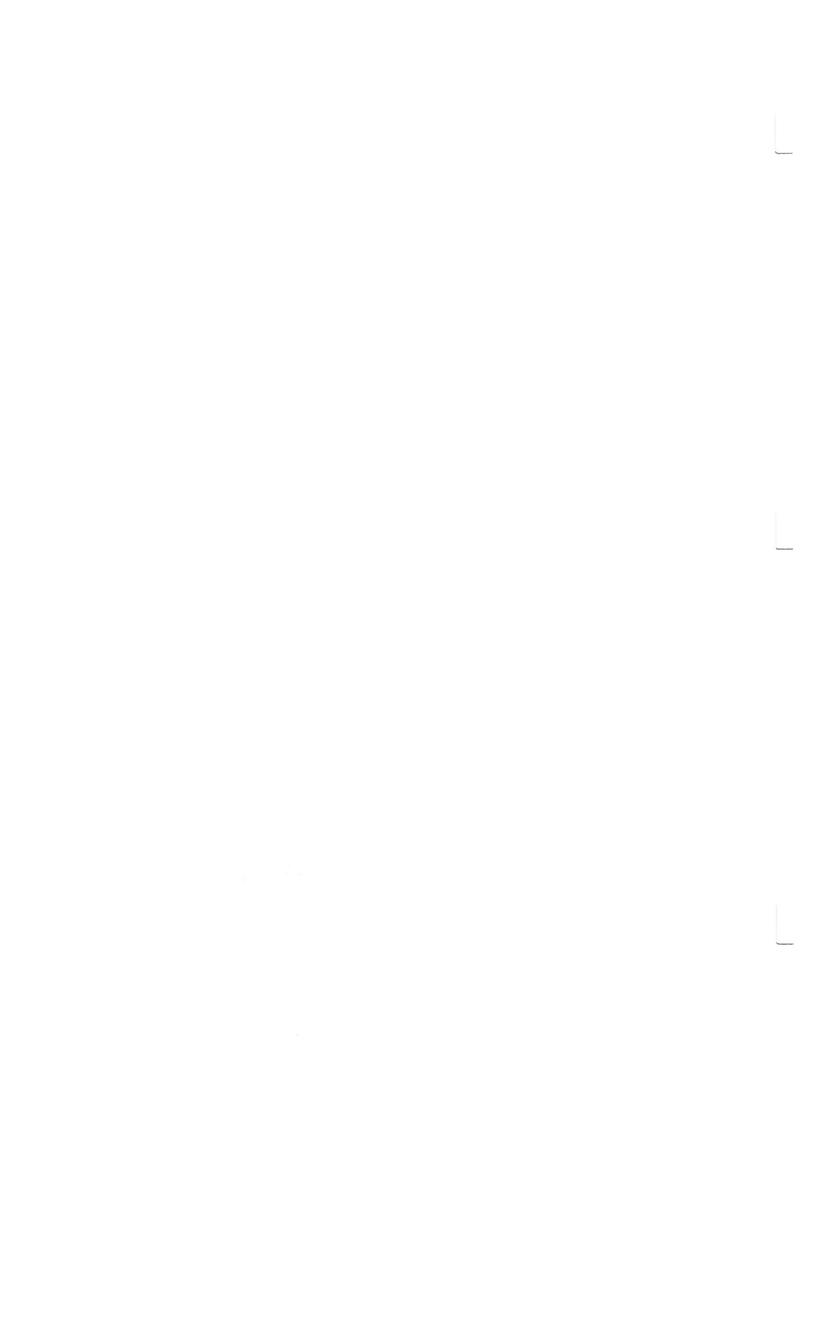

MEDICAL DIRECTOR Elle Djebiyan, M. D. I deeply appreciate the many years of support the Borough of Closter has provided to Spectrum for Living. With your assistance, Spectrum has received funding through the Community Development for more than twenty-five years, in order to provide a variety of invaluable services to adults with developmental disabilities and their families living throughout the Northern Valley region. These individuals and their families served are most grateful to these invaluable support services

In the upcoming year, Spectrum would like to submit a new project at the regional level and offer advocacy and support to adults with developmental disabilities living in the Northern Vailey communities. Many individuals and families are desperately in need of case managers and advocates to help them investigate and apply for needed services.

The 2022 Community Development Program will be even more essential in this upcoming year due to a combination of funding cuts and the New Jersey Division of Developmental Disabilities shift from a contract-based system of service reimbursement to a Medicaid-based, fee for services reimbursement system. As a consequence of these changes, a number of families are currently with inadequate or no appropriate services. This has been especially difficult for individuals and their families since the 2020 pandemic as many social service agencies were suspended to the public. Some programs never reopened, the industry continues to be plagued by staff shortages, and counselors, and other professionals have been difficult to reach by phone.

In order to complete the 2022 Community Development application process, a municipal resolution endorsing our Community Development Project will be required. A sample of the suggested resolution is attached.

I would appreciate if the resolution could be put on the Council's agenda as soon as practicable.

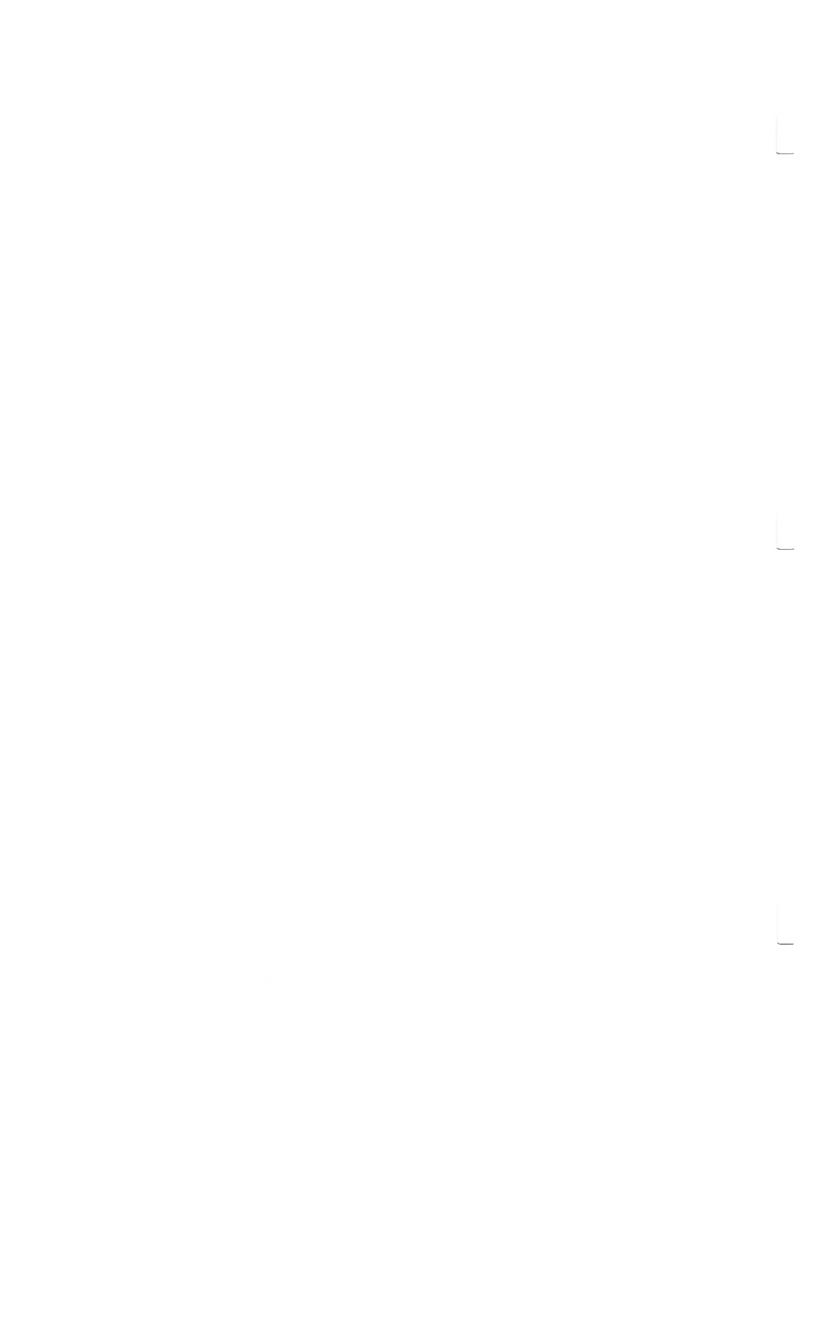

Resolution -Self- Examination of 2022 Municipal Budget

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-78b has authorized the Local Finance Board to adopt rules that permit municipalities in sound fiscal condition to assume the responsibility, normally granted to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services, of conducting the annual budget examination, and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 5:30-7 was adopted by the Local Finance Board on February 11, 1997, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.2 thru 7.5 the Borough of Closter has been declared eligible to participate in the program by the Division of Local Government Services, and the Chief Financial Officer has determined that the Borough meets the necessary conditions to participate in the program for the 2022 budget year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Closter that the 2022 municipal budget be examined in accordance with N.J.A.C. 5:30-7.6a & b and based upon the Chief Financial Officer's certification. The Borough Council has found the budget has met the following requirements:

- 1. That with reference to the following items, if applicable, the amounts have been calculated pursuant to law and appropriated as such in the budget.
 - a. Payment of interest and debt redemption charges
 - Deferred charges and statutory expenditures
 - c. Cash deficit of preceding year
 - d. Reserve for uncollected taxes
 - e. Other reserves and non-disbursement items
 - f. Any inclusions of amounts required for school purposes.
- 2. That the provisions relating to limitation on increases of appropriations pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-45.2 and appropriations for exceptions to limits on appropriations found at 40A:4-45.3 et seq. are fully met.
- 3. That the budget is in such form, arrangement, and content as required by the Local Budget Law and N.J.A.C. 5:30-4 and 5:30-5.
- 4. That pursuant to the Local Budget Law:
 - a. All estimates of revenue are reasonable, accurate, and correctly stated;
 - b. Items of appropriations are properly set forth
 - c. In itemization, form, arrangement, and content the budget will permit the exercise of the comptroller function within the municipality.
- 5. The budget and associated amendments have been introduced, publicly advertised, and adopted in accordance with the relevant provisions of the Local Budget Law, except that failure to meet the deadlines of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-5 shall not prevent such certification.
- 6. That all other applicable statutory requirements have been fulfilled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
