The Closter Office of Emergency Management passes on the following news from the State of New Jersey

Community-Based Testing Sites are for current New Jersey residents and members of New Jersey law enforcement agencies.

In order to be eligible for testing, individuals must be current New Jersey residents.

Effective Sunday, May 3, 2020, exhibiting symptoms is no longer a prerequisite for testing.

However, the **highest priority** for testing will be given to health care workers and workers in congregate living settings, and symptomatic first responders, as well as to asymptomatic NJ residents who have been in close contact with someone else who has tested positive.

The New Jersey base test site in Bergen County is Bergen Community College

The Bergen Community College drive thru testing site schedule will be 500 tests per day on Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. The site will be closed Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday. The site will be open from 0800 to 1600 hours.
