Rules/Guidelines for a Child to Collect the Cards

- 1. No Parent or Guardian should ask or collect a card for the child.
- 2. In order to collect an officer's trading card, the child should introduce themselves to the officer. This does not mean that the parent/guardian cannot accompany the child when speaking with the officer, but the child must be there to speak with the officer.
- 3. A child may come to the Closter Police Department at any time to collect a card, but should an officer not be inside, we respectfully ask that an officer is not requested to come into the police station solely to collect a card.
- 4. If a child loses an officer's trading card, they can approach the officer again to ask for a replacement card.
- 5. No child is to approach an officer while the officer is near his patrol car with the emergency lights activated or the officer is involved in some type of investigation.
- No child is to disregard their own safety because they see an officer and need their trading card.
- 7. When an officer is not working, they will not have their trading cards with them.
- 8. Children should not attempt to collect trading cards inside of the school, during the school day.
- 9. This program is designed for Closter residents only.
- 10. The program will be from September 10th 2022 until January 1st 2023
- 10. Collect all 23 cards, bring the collection form to Closter HQ and a police officer will sign the form confirming you have collected them all.
- 11. The child will then be entered into a raffle to win a prize the week of January 1st 2023!!!
